



Sunday Parking Guide

(subject to change as season goes on)



To prevent car park chaos on a Sunday, here is a little guide on how to get maximum parking usage. Obviously, the plan is not accurate regarding the number of cars in each row. The trick is to get as many parked neatly as possible. You will need to guide the cars into position; don't be afraid to ask them to move over if they are not parked close enough. It is estimated that by using every bit of space possible, you can park approximately 200 cars in the top two car parks.

You must leave enough space in the middle carpark for cars to get in and out of the rows and, more importantly, for an ambulance to get through the gate to the pitches.

You will need to collect a high viz jacket from the clubhouse 5 minutes before a shift and hand it back afterward (when you can also pick up a thank you hot drink from the bar)

Minis, you are needed from 08.45 (although 08.30 is ideal) until 09.30. I am afraid you have a busy shift, as you almost have to "build" the Tetris game. You will fill up the middle car park first, then the main car park, and only open the 12 acres if those two car parks are full.

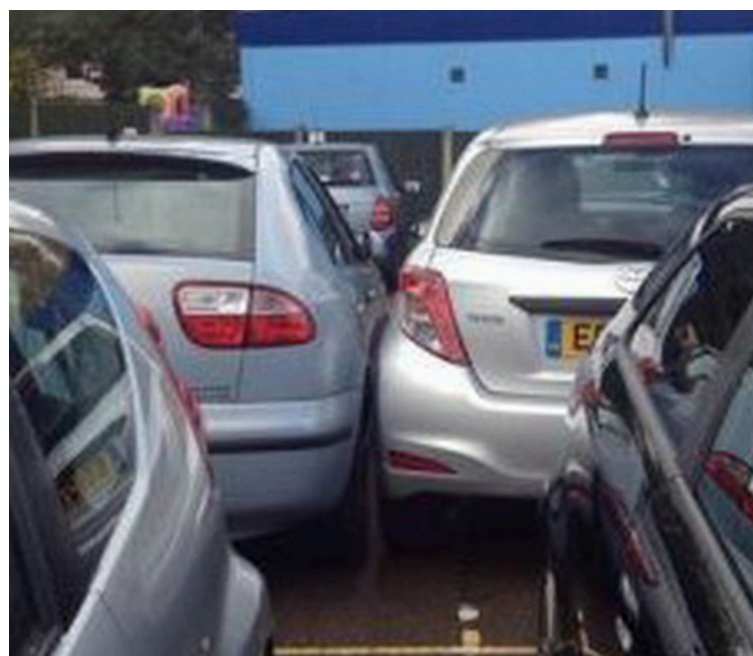
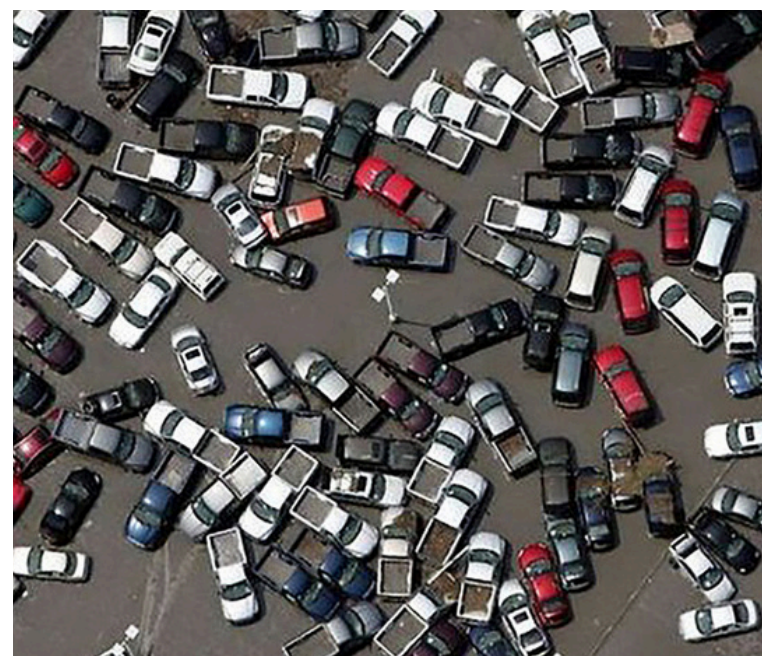
Juniors and Girls, you are needed from 10:45 (10.30 ideal) to 11.30. You have the awkward shift as you must guide people out and in! The most important part of your shift is guiding people in and out of the club and keeping Park Lane clear of traffic. Please position someone at the entrance to the club to keep an eye on traffic on the road. If traffic is backing up, you must direct people to turn right out of the club. Many of your parents will want to drop and run. Please get them to drop them off at the corner by the entrance to the clubhouse.

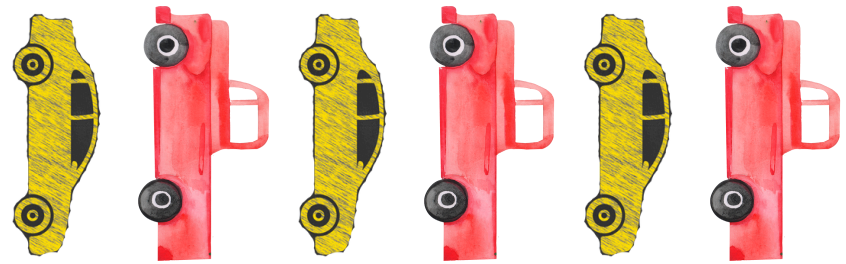
It is likely that footballers will try and park at the club. They are not allowed! Whoever is on the gate needs to politely turn them away.

Suggested marshalling spots are on the plans. There needs to be a permanent on the gate. Juniors and Girls you will need someone on the road as well. others are obviously free to move around as needed.

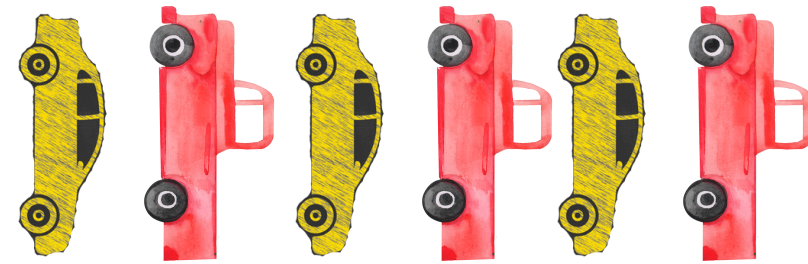
First ones there in the morning need to mark the emergency lane out in the middle carpark, using the cones which will be there. The access to 12 acres must be kept clear as well.

If you have any parents who are being problematic or rude please make a note of the carpark registration and their name/age group if possible and report it to Kate or one of the chairs.

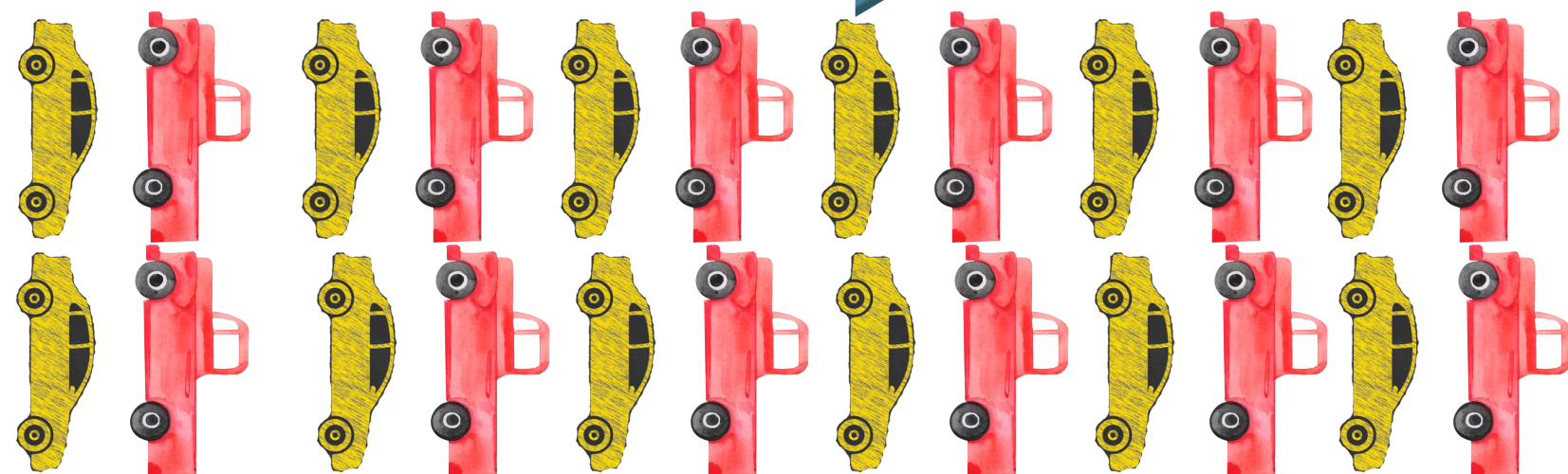
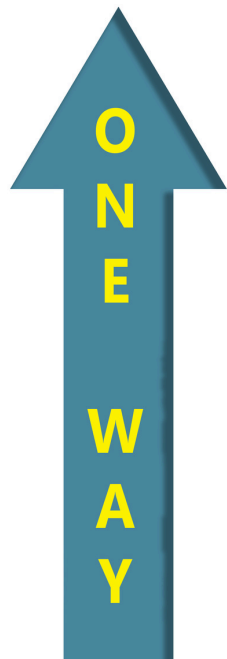
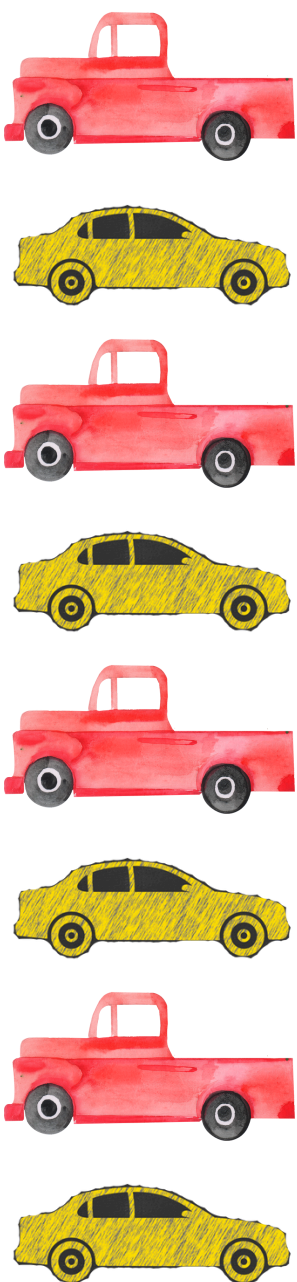




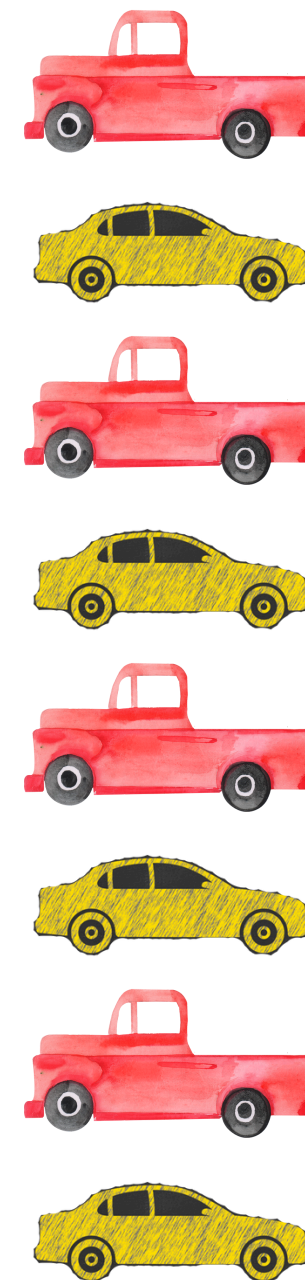
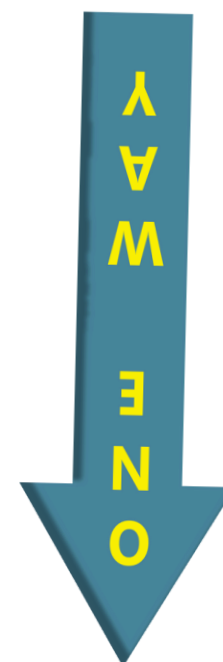
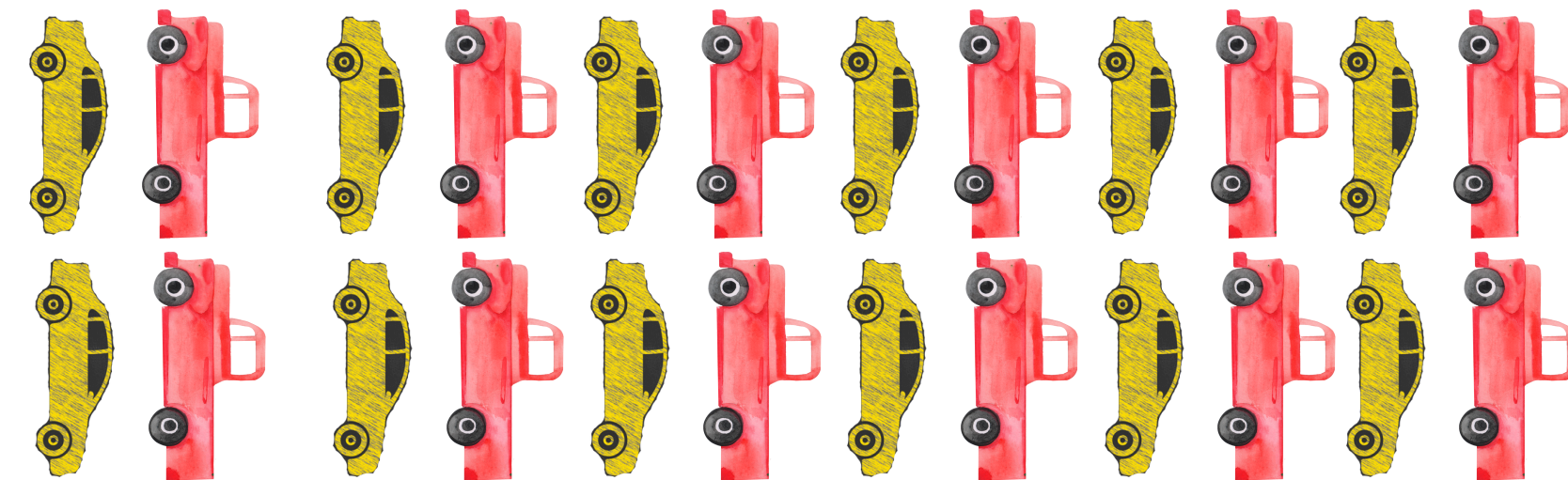

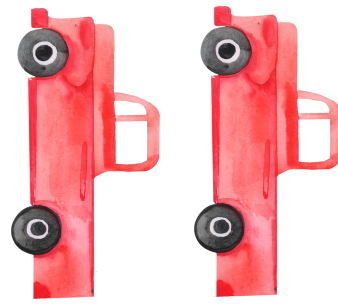
Entrance Gate

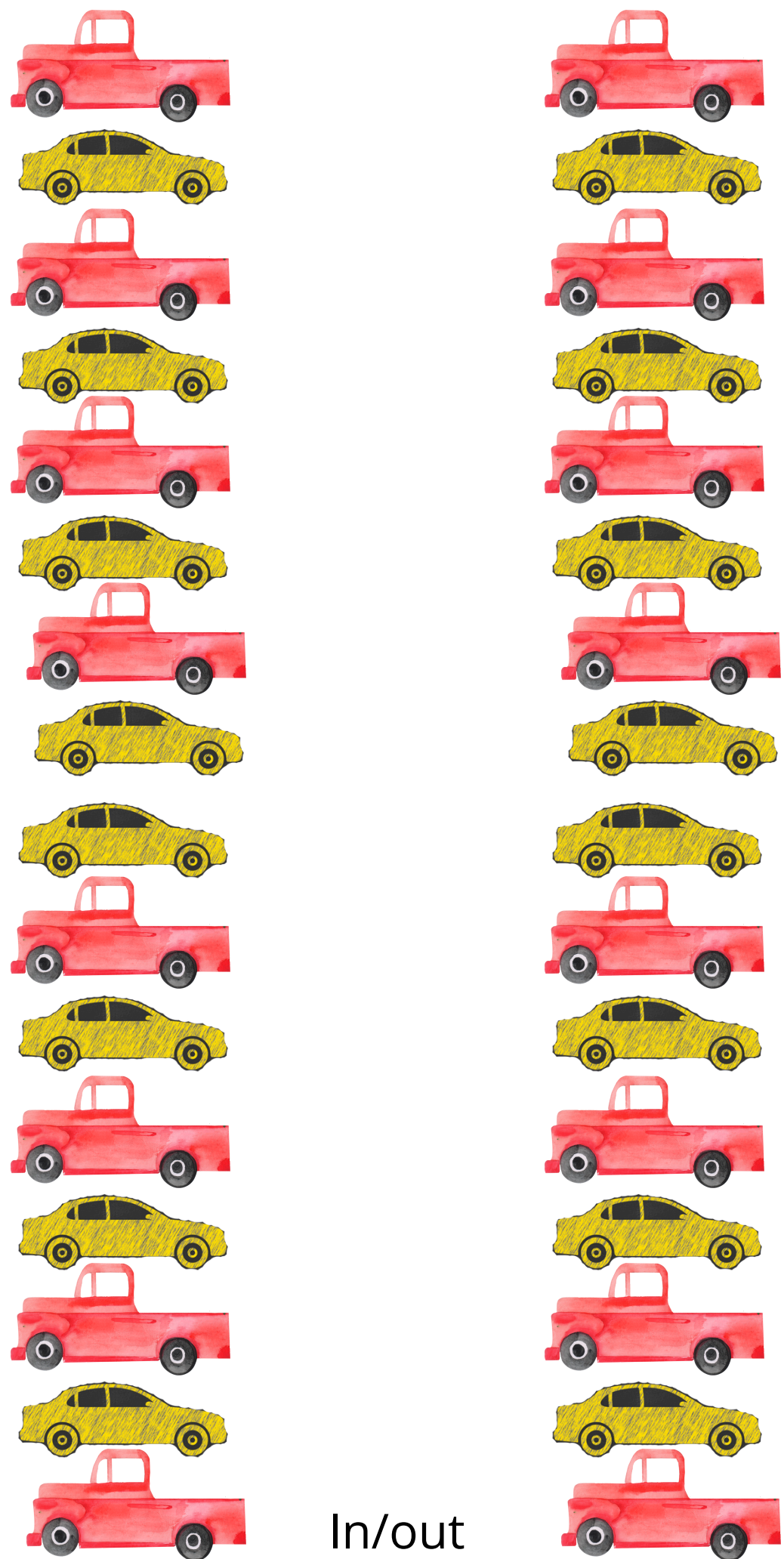
